Yesterday we had a meeting with the Mayor of Johannesburg on the current disputes between the City and the road closure community, namely automation and the locking of pedestrian gates. This meeting was arranged by the Chairman of the Hurlingham Manor Residents Association, Mr Rob Lage.

In short the Mayor advised that this administration recognizes that road closures are a response to crime, that they are necessitated by government's failure to protect its citizens and instructed the officials to work to find solutions to the current issues.
