Introduction

Incidents

The preservation of awareness and sharing of information on suspicious activities and criminal incidents will continue to assist in the combating of crime in the Woodrock area. Below is a breakdown of incidents reported during the reporting month.

Date Time	Type	Locality	Description
2.9.2016 13h28	DAMAGE TO PROPERTY	Lincoln Road	The client called in to report that he noticed tampering at the electric box outside his premises. The suspect left a screwdriver by the box. Upon investigation, it has become clear that a wire was disconnected. No further info available.
3.9.2016 20h32	SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE	Lincoln Road	The caretaker called the 24/7 control room to report a suspicious car outside the property. B75 was dispatched and upon arrival could not find any vehicles in the street. Adjacent streets were searched, but nothing suspicious detected.
6.9.2016 08h13	ASSISTANCE TO PUBLIC	Woodrock area	B75 reported that approximately 200 SSD Vuma staff members are working in the area. They are contracted to Telkom and are digging and laying cables. Extra patrols arranged.






6.9.2016 13h35	SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE	Hillman Road	The client called to report a suspicious vehicle outside his premises. B75 reported that it is the boyfriend of the domestic of the client who is visiting her. Feedback was given to the client.
12.9.2016 18h43	ASSISTANCE TO PUBLIC	Boom Gate	B75 reported that there is no guard on duty at the boom gate. The guard arrived for duty at 20h20.
18.9.2016 13h17	ARMED RESIDENTIAL ROBBERY	Singer Street	Non 24/7 client. 3 Suspects derailed the gate and accessed the house. They found the domestic in the house and pointed her with a firearm. The resident's son was also at home. They were both told to co-operate. They took a large amount of appliances from the house and fled in a silver Corsa. No registration number was taken. No injuries were sustained and the resident does not belong to a security service provider.
24.9.2016 21h30	SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES	Cnr Golfview & Lincoln Rd	A resident reported a silver Toyota Cressida with two male occupants sitting on the corner and appear to be suspicious. The officer of B75 investigated and reported that the guard at Onix Complex confirmed that it belongs to the gardener that is employed by the complex.
28.9.2016 13h10	ARMED ROBBERY & SHOOTING	Lincoln Street	A resident at The Pass was acosted by 3 armed suspects who entered the complex with him. They attempted to hijack him, but instead took his watch and several items from the back of the vehicle. 2 of the suspects held the guard at the gate up and took his panic and remote as well as a DVR system, CCTV cameras that was installed in the guardhouse. On their way out of the complex, they were met by B75 and opened fire. B75 fired one shot at the suspects as they passed him. Damage to the reaction vehicle was sustained. No arrests have been made and no injuries sustained.



Vehicle Statistics


Following are the vehicle statistics of B75 for September. The graph indicate the amount of kilometres travelled by the vehicle for the month as well as an average per day.

Response vehicles in Woodrock area responding at an average response time of 2 minutes and 18 seconds per activation.




Suspicious Vehicles
