

GETTING STAKEHOLDERS TOGETHER

16 November 2016

On Monday evening we hosted an information session between private security companies and City officials to discuss road closures.

The security companies were educated on the process of Road Closure applications and re-applications and were guided as to the do's and don'ts of the Road Closure Policy. Some security companies expressed their frustration at the ban of automation and the problems with pedestrian gate monitoring. We pointed out that we are negotiating with the Municipality on these issues. Security companies highlighted that, in the meantime, the City was taking steps to remove automated structures.

The City officials recommended that we approach Lisa Seftel (Executive Director of Transport) to discuss holding off on penalizing areas that make use of automation whilst negotiations are in progress.

Following the feedback and interaction during this meeting, we have made contact with Ms Seftel requesting an urgent meeting.

We will keep you advised of progress in this regard.
