Theft out of motor vehicle was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Pertinent Detail:

In a business robbery incident that occurred at Woodmead Drive on 2017-07-18 at about 09:30, the complainant was inside the store with customers when approached by two males. The suspects took their belongings and fled the scene. Investigation continues.
